This past year has once again seen swimming stalwarts pass away and in particular our Patron, Doug Cain OBE – Life Member of Swimming New Zealand, Life Member of Canterbury West Coast Swimming and of the Wharenui Club. He was known throughout NZ as “Mr Swimming” a true indication of the dedication and commitment that Doug Cain has given to swimming over many, many years.

This year we have been fortunate enough to secure further funding for the Development Officer. After a year of ably setting this position up, Louise Stevenson has regrettably resigned as she has full time employment. Our new Development Officer is Mrs Samantha Von Hagen who is very eager to continue Louise’s good work.

The number of registered swimmers is still down on previous years and while our bigger clubs have reasonable numbers some of the smaller clubs are struggling to survive. Our Junior Meets are usually well attended and it is always a pleasure to see those younger swimmers achieve their goals.

Congratulations to all those swimmers who have achieved success in the last year, whether it be a NZ Medal or a personal best time and congratulations to the coaches who have enabled their swimmers to obtain their goals.

At the Canterbury Sir Richard Hadlee Sports Awards, Ben Pickersgill-Brown took the Junior Male Sportsperson for the second consecutive year. Well done Ben!

Swimming excelled at the Canterbury Summer Sports Awards with Ron Clarke achieving the overall Administrator Award, Greg Crawford long service to the sport, and recognition was given to our coach, Brigitte Mahan, Sportsperson Annabelle Carey, and Young Sports Achiever Adam Van Opzeeland. Congratulations to you all.

Canterbury West Coast Swimming for the first time ever, hosted the NZ Winter Championships in September. While the meet itself was a success we did experience a few problems – like pool seating, music and access. Hopefully we can overcome most of these problems for our next major meet. We were very unfortunate to miss out on hosting NZ Opens 2004 due to the unavailability of QEII pool. In the New Year we will host NZ Juniors and NZ Age Groups. Swimming New Zealand has an exciting Strategic Plan with many changes in place from 2004 – 2008. For the sport to progress forward, the regions need to support this plan.

A special thank you to all the officials who so willingly give their time to officiate at our meets – your help is essential in the organising and running of our sport.

**Doug Cain, OBE 31.7.1919 – 25.09.2003**  
**Life Member & Patron of Canterbury West Coast Swimming**  
**Life Member of Swimming New Zealand**  
**Life Member & Patron of Wharenui Swim Club**  
**Selector for Swimming New Zealand**

Doug Cain was fondly known throughout New Zealand as “Mr. Swimming” but the name of Doug Cain is synonymous with the Wharenui Swim Club.

Doug was passionate about swimming the Wharenui Swim Club. Our recollections of Doug are that we can never recall him saying the words “it can’t be done”. Doug would say “there has to be a better way and how can it be done”. It was with his passion, his vision and his dogged determination that Doug was able to promote swimming throughout the country, promote the Wharenui Swim Club and make things happen.

The 1974 Commonwealth Games in Christchurch was one of the proudest achievements of the Wharenui Swim Club and ultimately gave Doug the most pride for the swimming club that he had been involved with for over almost 30 years. Every swimming medal won by a New Zealander at those Commonwealth Games went to a swimmer from Wharenui.

Doug Cain has been the doyen of swimming in Canterbury and New Zealand for almost 60 years. Whenever ceremonial duties had to be carried out, Doug with his long time friend Noel Smith carried those duties out to perfection! Doug was an official at three Commonwealth Games and was the recipient of a Sport Canterbury Award for 50 years service to swimming. He was awarded the OBE for services to swimming in 1994. Doug was also awarded by Riccarton Rotary the Paul Harris Fellow Award which has only been presented to non-Rotarians twice in the last 50 years. Doug Cain will be forever remembered by the Wharenui Swim Club.

### **NOLA GILLARD**

Died 26.9.03

For 25 years Nola has been involved with swimming at the Wharenui Swim Club with her children Grant and Bridgette. She became Vice-President and in 1993 became President, a role she kept until 2001. Nola was a life Member of the Wharenui Swim Club, received a Canterbury Swimming service award in 1987 and honours 10 years later and Swimming New Zealand service award in 2001. Nola was also a Trustee on the Doreen Brown Trust.

She was team manager on many occasions both for Canterbury and New Zealand. Nola was also more than willing to help with the catering for swim meets or anything else that needed doing as long as it was not timekeeping! Nola preferred to be with the swimmers. Such was Nola’s involvement with travel, that The Gillard Family Trust was set up by Ray and Nola for Wharenui swimmers.

With the passing of Nola, it leaves a huge void and especially Nola’s knowledge of the history of the Club where she played such a huge part. She will be sadly missed.

### WINTER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

QEII Christchurch

21 – 25 September 2003

This year a team of 52 swimmers from the Aquagym, Jasi, Kaiapoi, QEII and Wharenuī Swim Clubs, accompanied by their coaches, represented the Canterbury region at the New Zealand Winter Championships. The seating arrangement at the pool was such that members of club teams sat together within a regional area, consequently both individual and combined team spirit was high throughout the meet. This seating arrangement in conjunction with the cooperative support and pleasant approachable demeanor of the respective Club Coaches and Club Team Managers ensured the mostly smooth execution of my responsibilities.

Generally the meet ran efficiently with morning sessions running to schedule and evening sessions only slightly delayed by the introduction of an unofficial race at the end of each finals session. This was agreed to in order to give the Australian Junior Development Squad members the experience of swimming heats in the morning and the opportunity to race in the finals session each evening. New Zealand swimmers were also invited to enter the chosen event each evening. Here it is appropriate to acknowledge that there is a considerable amount of preparation that goes into a meet like this and its smooth running is a credit to the organisational skills of the many officials who volunteer their time for the five days.

Congratulations to all Canterbury West Coast swimmers who acquitted themselves well. Our relay teams performed well showing a splendid cooperative effort by both coaches and swimmers to create the best Canterbury teams possible. But the accolades should go to all those individuals who achieved personal bests and exceeded expectations. Special congratulations should go to Elliot Box (Aquagym), Annabelle Carey (Wharenuī), Steven Lim (Wharenuī), Ben Pickersgill-Brown (Aquagym), Georgina Toomey (Jasi) and Annelise Wolt (Aquagym), who all set new Canterbury West Coast records during the meet, some of them even bettering their own records several times in a combination of heats, semi-finals and finals. Ben Pickersgill-Brown also took the New Zealand Short Course Age Group Record Standard for 16 year old males in 100m Free with a time of 51.20,

and Georgina Toomey also took a New Zealand record – the New Zealand Short Course Age Group Record for 16 year old females in 50m Fly with a time of 27.69. This time also gave her the New Zealand Short Course Open Record for 50m Fly.

At this point I would like to take the opportunity to thank Canterbury West Coast management for the chance to act as Team Manager for this meet. It was rewarding to meet again with officials with whom I have worked previously and to make the acquaintance of many others and the variety of situations which presented both extended and developed my knowledge of swimming regulations and administration. Although after a well-justified protest on behalf of one of the Canterbury swimmers was declined along with the subsequent appeal between Sessions 3 and 4, I feel the question of why we volunteer to help needs to be asked. Surely the needs and rights of our swimmers are paramount. To me there is no place for egos in the support role held by officials.

112 Canterbury swimmers competed at the 2003 championships. This was down on last year when the championships were at "home" with 142 swimmers, but comparable to previous years.

Southland Swimming were excellent hosts, well organised with the meet running very smoothly. I found the officials and organisers very helpful and easy to work with and there was ample seating for the teams and spectators. Heats were over the top starts except for backstroke, and this did cut down on time but I consider this would have been fine for backstroke as well. Morning heat sessions were finished between 11.30 and noon. However the evening sessions were a bit long, medal presentations were drawn out because they announced and waited for the medalists but the swimmers could not get there as they were waiting in marshalling for their next final. All the relay medal presentations were held at the conclusion of the final session and this worked very well.

The Canterbury swimmers, coaches and team managers were all a pleasure to be involved with. A few scratchings were necessary due to sickness or injury. One swimmer had not entered in the meet but had travelled down to swim. The meet organisers very kindly entered him as exhibition only in available lanes, however as there was ample chance for clubs to ensure their entries were correct before travelling I feel this situation should never have arisen.

The swimming was good with few disqualifications, however I felt that times were quite slow. No Canterbury records were broken this year and only 3 individual meet records broken, one equalled and two relay records broken.

## **NEW ZEALAND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2004**

This year the Southern Zone of the New Zealand Junior Championships was held in Dunedin at Moana Pool bringing together young swimmers from Canterbury West Coast, Eastern Districts, Otago and Southland. It was a small meet with only 115 swimmers entered, 49 of whom were from the Canterbury West Coast region.

Of course all the young swimmers wanted to do their best and subsequently began the weekend with a keen air of anticipation. The Canterbury West Coast team was no different, although this year, the clubs representing the region did not all sit as closely together as they might have which did not make for a totally cohesive regional team spirit but certainly kept me fit! Nevertheless club team managers and coaches must be congratulated on the professional, co-operative, courteous and approachable manner in which they conducted the business of the weekend. Our swimmers were also well behaved and co-operative, and if the small group who represented our region in the march-past during the official opening is a measure of the moral calibre of our swimmers, then they are a group that we, as Canterbury West Coast Management, must be truly proud of.

Each swimmer was given a copy of the programme for the Southern Zone containing details of the opening ceremony, lists of competitors and officials, a list of sponsors, other useful information and all the details of the weekend's swimming. Team managers and coaches were also given separate session sheets which also contained the programme for the swimmers competing in the open events interspersed with the championship events in order to fill out each session.

In spite of these extra swimmers there was still a lot of waiting for national results to come through and indeed the first results were not announced until approximately 11.00am during the first session. These considerable delays made the meet tedious at times with a subsequent lack of energy, excitement and atmosphere. For young swimmers attending their first national meet this is hardly ideal and is an issue that needs to be addressed by the organizing committee for New Zealand Juniors.

Many of our swimmers were disconcerted by the starting signal at Moana Pool. Consequently there were some slow starts since swimmers were not all tuned into the whistle-like sound. However Lyn Sutherland the Southern Zone Meet Director did recall a number of swimmers and restart their races when she considered that their efforts would have been compromised by the start. This occurred principally during the 50m races where the swimmers were started at the lap pool end of the 50m pool and for some reason the starting signal was not as clear. Upon inquiry I was told that it was not possible to use other starting equipment since this gear was specific to the electronic timing equipment at the pool. However I did discover that the equipment was new, had only arrived a day or two before the meet and obviously had just been installed. The fact that there were 'teething' problems with it was apparent. On a positive note I guess that it is good for swimmers to learn to adjust to different methods of starting a race and to learn that it is vital to concentrate and focus on what they are about to do, but it is harsh to expect that to happen at a national meet.

Many of the swimmers who achieved placings within the regional competition were disappointed with the quality of the ribbons awarded to them and I would have to agree. They were small, quite unattractive and generally insignificant; certainly not an appropriate accolade for a young swimmer achieving success at a national meet. Our Junior Carnival ribbons and the ribbons awarded at the annual Queen's Birthday Neptune Meet are far more attractive. This is also a matter to be addressed by the organizing committee for New Zealand Juniors.

Although Canterbury West Coast swimmers appeared frequently as place getters in the Southern Zone competition, national results were not as good as in previous years. The Canterbury West Coast tally was only 5 national medals - 3 silver and 2 bronze medals. These went to Penny Hayes (Aquagym) – 2 silver medals for the Girls’ 12 Year Olds 100m Freestyle (1.04.94) and for the Girls’ 12 Year Olds 200m I.M. (2.38.57), David Chapman (Wharenui) – 1 silver medal for the Boys’ 12 Year Olds 100m Breaststroke (1.22.06), and 1 bronze medal for the Boys’ 12 Year Olds 200m Breaststroke (2.57.25) and Sam Wright (Wharenui)– 1 bronze medal for the Boys’ 11 Year Olds 200m Freestyle (2.24.55).

The relay teams performed well at regional level with each of the 4 teams entered gaining first place. Nationally, however, they did not fare so well with the Girls’ 12 & Under 200m Freestyle relay and the Girls’ 12 & Under 200m Medley relay coming fourth nationally; the Boys’ 12 & Under 200m Medley relay was fourth and the Boys’ 12 & Under 200m Freestyle relay was sixth.

The Southern Zone organizing committee ran, in addition to the official relays, an unofficial relay in each event. There was no entry cost for any team and, of course, no awards for the winners but the concept of giving more swimmers the opportunity to experience relay swimming at representative level was well received by the regions present. After consultation with the Canterbury West Coast coaches the decision was made to enter our reserve teams in each event and they performed exceedingly well, winning each of their events.

Finally I would like to express my thanks to the Canterbury West Coast Management committee for giving me the opportunity to care for our team. Each time I do this, I learn so much more and expand the depth of my knowledge about swimming. Although I have observed some administrators who seem to do this work as a form of self gratification, there are also a lot of people who volunteer a considerable amount of their own time for the purpose for which I would hope that we are all here – to support and encourage our swimmers to be the best they can.

Coaches would have liked to have seen two relays in some age groups as time difference was not much and would have been good experience for some swimmers.
